9th LAND-ART FESTIVAL COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

General provisions

The main aim of the competition is to choose the projects, which will be carried out during the 9th edition of the Lublin's Land Art festival held between 3rd to 13th July 2019.

Festival's Organizers are Foundation "Latająca Ryba" and Marshal Office of Lublin Voivodeship.

§1 Projects

- 1. The place of carrying out and presentation of the chosen projects: green areas of the Łucki Bishops' Castle in Janów Podlaski and the village of Stare Buczyce.
- 2. The main keyword of the 9th edition is "Garden". A detailed description of the idea can be found at: http://landart.lubelskie.pl/competition
- **3.** The projects should should refer to the main keyword formally and artistically as well as highlight natural properties and the specific character of the presentation's location.

§2 Conditions of participation

- 1. A physical person of 18 years or over, or a group of people with a documented artistic output, as well as students of architecture, landscape architecture, design, film and photography at higher artistic schools can participate in the competition.
- 2. To take a part in the competition, a project of an installation/work which meets the requirements mentioned in \$1 should be submitted until April 28th 2019
- 3. Projects should be submitted in a descriptive and graphic form, along with a filled in ENTRY CARD.
- 4. Every participant may submit any number of works.
- 5. Organizers do not take responsibility for applications which arrive late or are lost without the Organizers fault.
- 6. Participation in competition is free and completely voluntary.
- 7. Participation in competition equals with acceptation of the provisions of the present Terms and Regulations.

§3 Competition's results

- 1. All properly registered entries will take a part in the competition that will consist in the evaluation and choice of the most interesting projects. The choice will be made by a Festival Board appointed by the Organizers.
- 2. The Board's decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
- 3. Of all the properly registered entries, the Board will select the projects to be carried out in the framework of the festival. Number of projects to be carried out shall be determined by the Organizer.
- 4. The costs associated with the carrying out of the chosen project will be determined individually on the basis of data provided in the Entry Card.
- 5. Competition's results will be announced at <u>www.landart.lubelskie.pl</u> and at <u>facebook.com/FundacjaLatajacaRyba</u>.
- 6. Selected participants will be informed by email or phone.

§4 Final provisions

- 1. With the granting of the right to carry out installation / work, winner of the competition transfers a part of the selected project's copyright to the Festival's Organizer. Transfer of copyright and related rights applies to the following fields of use: preservation of the project on all media including computer disk, CD, on a photographs, reproduction by any technique, use of the project in the economic circulation in all forms acceptable by law.
- 2. By submitting his work to the competition participant declares that he has all and unrestricted copyright to the project.
- 3. By submitting his work to the competition participant declares that the work submitted does not infringe third parties rights, in particular their personal and copyright property.
- 4. Participant agrees to bear all the costs of claims arising from the violation of the rights referred to above.
- 5. Participant who decides to take part in the competition consents to the competition rules included in this Terms and Conditions.
- 6. All contents included in the advertising and promotional materials are for information only. The provisions of this Terms and Conditions have binding legal force.
